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Introduction

This report is an extension of the Wayfinding Signage Study from November 2007, with the purpose of developing new signage for Fountain's Historic Downtown. The project goal was the creation of a cohesive signage system, useful for both visitors and residents, that would also strengthen the visual identity of Historic Fountain. The project requirements called for:

- •Determination of locations for signage within Historic Downtown Fountain;
- •Development of a conceptual design for new signage;
- •Estimation of individual sign cost and the total system cost;

The Colorado Center for Community Development (CCCD) sought to achieve these requirements while unifying the design with the existing signage design set forth in the Wayfinding Signage Study of 2007.

Sign design concepts, sizes, locations, and directional information were developed through a study of the wayfinding signage as well as meetings with Fountain representatives. Through a series of meetings, initial design concepts and sign details were refined. The final concept, including sign locations, design, color, and materiality reflects a desire for signage that is representative of Historic Fountain.

Signage Map

This map shows locations for the Historic Downtown signs in the downtown area of Fountain, as well as the Designation Signs and Directional Signs that are within the Historic Downtown boundaries.

The primary goal for Fountain's Historic Downtown signage system is to alert visitors that they are within the historic district of the town. Signage will clearly demarcate the boundaries of the historic downtown while also presenting a consistent and recognizable image for the historic area. The signage will also create a visual sequence that assures unfamiliar users will find their destination quickly and efficiently. Locations of Directional Signs and Destination Signs within the historic downtown are taken from the wayfinding signage done in November 2007. The cohesive signage system will not only direct users, but will strengthen the identity of the historic area of Fountain, creating a unique sense of place for residents and visitors.



Boundary Sign


Boundary Signs demarcate the boundary of the historic downtown. It alerts visitors and residents that they have entered the historic area of the town and promotes a recognizable image for the historic area.



Directional Sign

Directional Signs indicate directions to two or fewer destinations. Directional signs can be useful for both vehicle traffic and pedestrians on smaller arterial streets. Designed to stand alone, these signs can be attached to existing support structures, such as light poles, if necessary.


Signage Details




★ Destination Sign

Destination signs indicate arrival at a particular destination within the historic downtown of Fountain. These signs are identical to the tertiary signs, except that they only identify a single location and do not display an arrow.

Cost Estimate

Cost Estimates: These are estimated costs for the Fountain way-finding signage conceptual master plan. The estimates are based on previous Colorado Center for Community Development (CCCD) estimates, phone quotes from various service providers and manufacturer quotes from various sign companies. The calculations are based on the conceptual sign drawings and sign quotes, and do not represent final construction costs. These estimates are intended merely as a tool to guide the development process, drawing attention to cost considerations, and providing an idea of the possible range of cost.

Note: Both High Pressure Laminate and Aluminum have been used for cost estimates. Actual construction cost will be based on the manufacturer's estimate for material and construction of all the wayfinding signage throughout Fountain.
