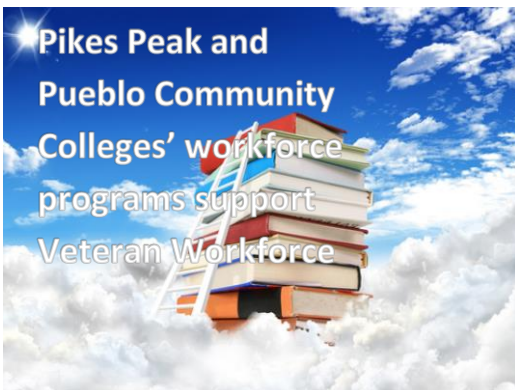

Fort Carson Army Post - Home of the US Army 4th Infantry Division and 10th Special Forces Group. Unique environment for mountain and high altitude training

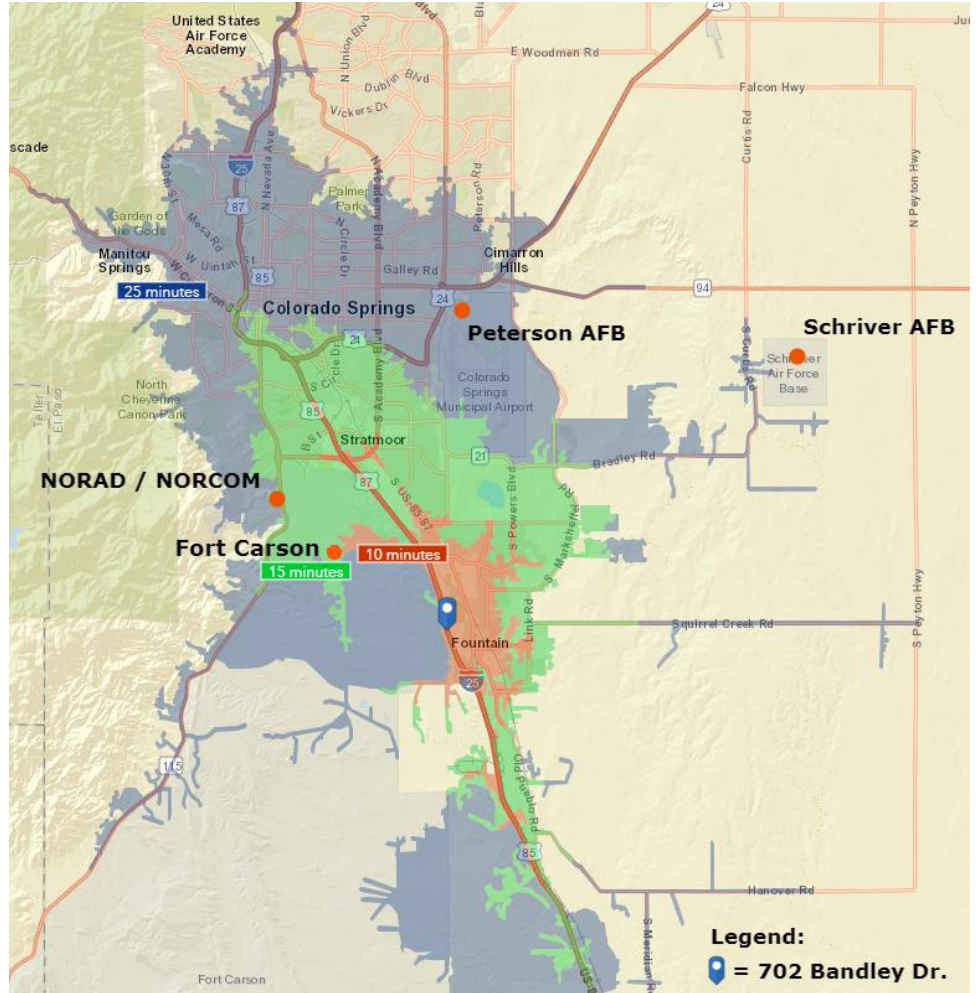
DRIVE TIME MAP – Fountain, CO
